



The Linden-Museum houses one of the largest ethnological collections in Europe. The collection of everyday objects and art objects is presented in the permanent exhibitions Africa, Orient, East Asia and South/South East Asia. The Linden-Museum regards itself as a living venue for intercultural dialog and a meeting place for an increasingly culturally diverse city.

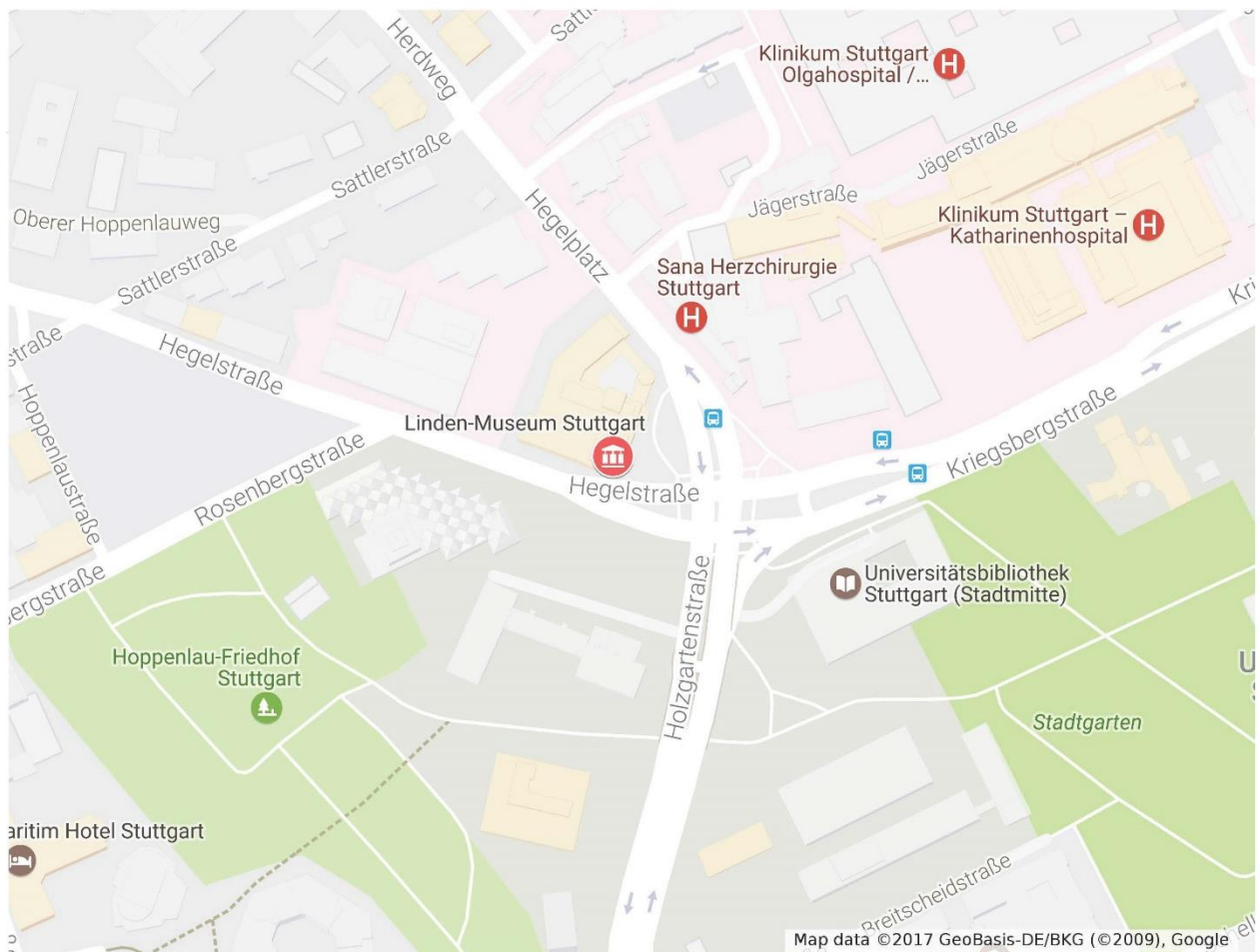
The Linden-Museum Stuttgart is open from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday to Saturday. Extended hours until 6 p.m. on Sundays and Bank Holidays. The museum is closed on Mondays.

Admission for adults to the Permanent Exhibition is 4 Euros (discount tickets: 3 Euros) and 10 Euros for the Special Exhibition (discount tickets: 8 Euros). Combined ticket for both are 13 Euros (discount tickets: 10 Euros/ Family ticket: 26 Euros. **Admission is free for Refugees.** Admission is free for everybody Saturday 10-12 a.m.
